

Tattoo Aftercare Instructions



The final result of your tattoo isn't only reliant on how well the artist does his job, but also heavily relies on how well you take care of it until it fully heals as well as throughout the rest of your life! After your tattoo is complete I will send you out with a specially engineered plastic wrap

Although my Derm shield is latex-free, hypoallergenic, and FDA approved if you are allergic to any adhesives please let me know in advance, but you shouldn't worry if redness or exfoliation of your skin occurs, that will all go away after the Derm wrap has been removed!

Derm wrap helps protect you from infectious pathogens, and retain moisture to properly heal! Derm wrap is a breathable plastic, and needs to stay on for 5 days or at least 3 days if it won't stay on! Because of the cool water-resistant technology you can shower with it on so leave it as long as it can stay on but avoid submerging the tattoo for the initial two weeks for the best healing process! When ready to take off

Throughout the healing process, your body will produce excessive body fluid as well as blood, this is normal and is a way for your body trying to recover and heal itself, so while your Derm wrap is on don't try to drain the excessive body fluid that has been built up, instead let it stay in the Derm wrap and let your skin reabsorb it back! In case it starts leaking just dab it with a paper towel. To take off the Derm Shield simply, gently peel back the plastic as you would with a bandage, it is best and easiest during a shower especially with warm water, along with mild or antibacterial hand soap!

Let the tattoo AIR DRY ONLY, to avoid getting it contaminated, don't touch it, and try to keep it away from pets for the time being from the area! And generously moisturize the tattooed area with UNSCENTED LOTION, there's no need for ointments! Repeat the washing and moisturizing twice a day until you notice your skin is back to its normal state or for at least a week! Try to avoid direct sun exposure to your tattoo at all times, and apply a generous amount of sunscreen on it especially during summer and sunny seasons to avoid fading and discoloration of your tattoo and to prolong its life! You paid a great amount of money on it so take care of it to keep it looking fresh and crisp. Whatever you take care of lasts!
